To look for the gold

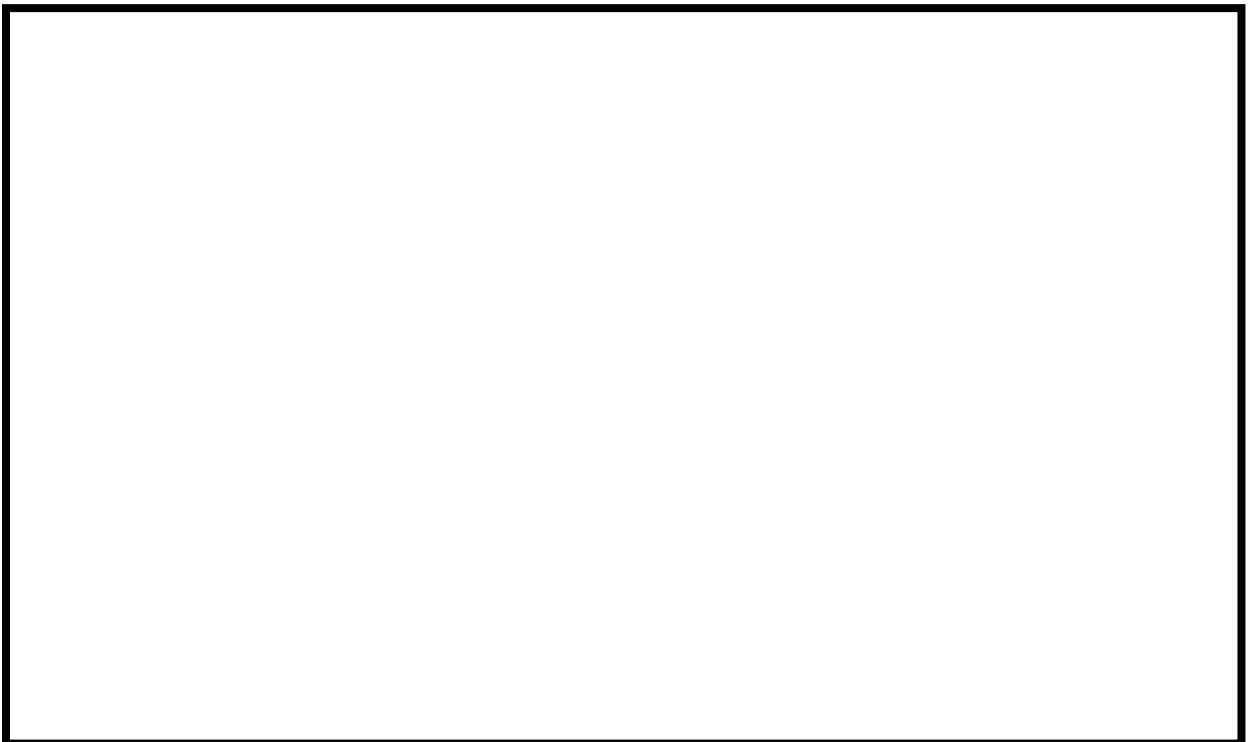
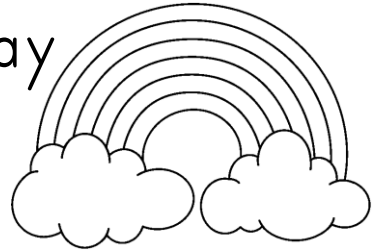
That was hidden far away.

He ran to get the gold.



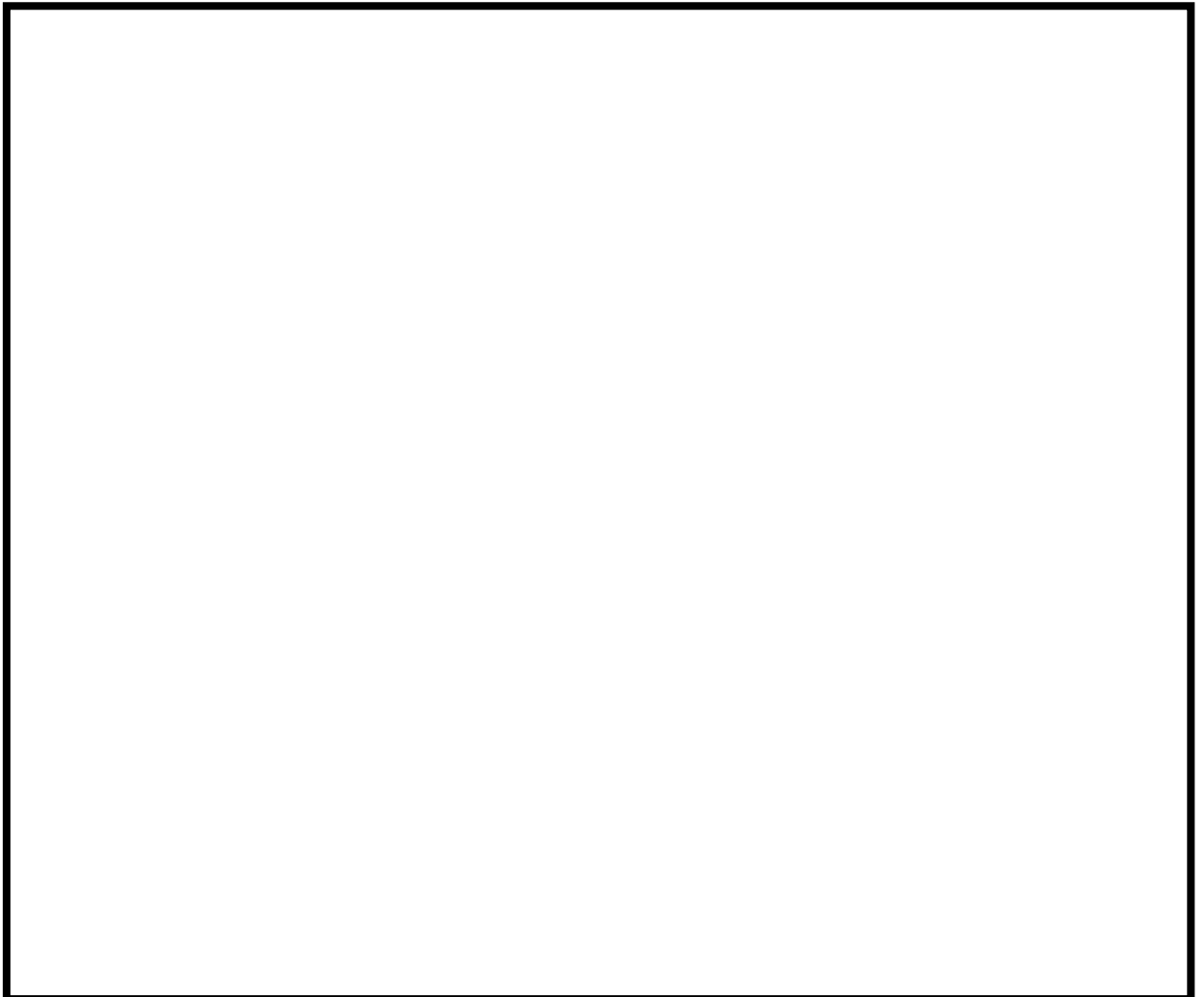


I'm a Little Shamrock

This is leprechaun sad.

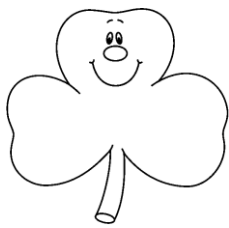

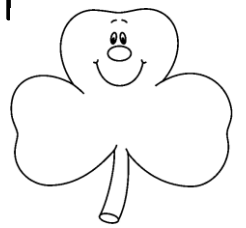

But with his gold he is best of all.



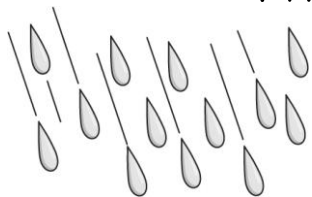


Seasons

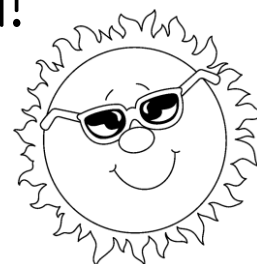


Winter, Spring, Summer, Fall,
